Framed Corkboard Display

The perfect gift solution for teachers, students, moms, and more, this framed corkboard display can be used to display anything from recipes and photos to important notes!

Supplies

Unfinished wood frame
Acrylic paint
Foam brushes
Cork sheets
Craft knife
E-6000 adhesive
Fabric button kit
Fabric scrap
Push pins
Ribbon



Step 1: Paint Your Frame

Apply 2-3 light coats of acrylic paint to the frame with a foam brush. Allow the base coat to dry completely before embellishing with additional painted decorative details, such as the polka dots on the frame above. Allow the paint to dry completely.

Step 2: Cut and Adhere the Cork Piece

Using a craft knife, cut a piece of cork that is the size of the frame opening. Use E-6000 to adhere the cork inside the frame.

Step 3: Make the Covered-Button Push Pins

Cover 2-3 buttons from the covered-button kit according to the instructions included in the kit. Adhere a push pin to the back of each with E-6000.

Step 4: Add Additional Embellishments

If desired, adhere additional embellishments, such as a ribbon bow, to the frame.
